
Assembly

1 Attaching the table legs to the table top 2 Attaching the leg connector

- Place the table top (A) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
- $\ ^{\square}$ Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) with the M6 x 20 mm bolts (AA).



- Attach the leg connector (C) to the table legs (B) with M6 x 25 mm bolts (BB).
- □ Tighten all the bolts with the M6 Allen wrench (CC).







Assembly

1 Attaching the T-rock to the chair body frame

- Place the chair frame (A) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
- Attach the T-rock (C) to the chair frame with four M8 x 35mm hex bolts in the order of M8 nuts (DD), M8 spring washers (CC), M8 washers (BB), steel plates (D), M8 washers (BB).
- □ Tighten all the M8 x 35mm bolts (AA) with M8 hex wrench (EE).



2 Connecting the chair base to the chair bucket

3 Adding the cushions
